**Organizational Meeting:** A motion to approve the meeting dates was made by Hemstock, a second was made by Holland; a vote of 5-0 was entered.

**Kent County Sheriff's Report:** Sheriff Price reviewed the report for March 2015. There were 62 speed assignments resulting in 42 warnings and 45 citations. The Sheriff's Department responded to 7 non-criminal complaints and 3 criminal complaints; Theft from vehicle, bomb threat, drug arrest. Hemstock mentioned a problem when calling the 911 service.

Queen Anne's County Sheriff Deputy was also present. Morales mentioned heavy traffic and syringes on the trails at the Water front park. QAC Deputy said call the sheriff's office when traffic is noticeable on those trails

**Maryland Environmental Services Report:** Don Reed reviewed the report for March 2015. There were no violations at the WWTP or the WTP. Hydrants were flushed on April 9, 2015. No sludge was removed from the plant. 2 locates were performed. Changed oil in all blower units. Received complaints about discoloration of the water. MRW will be in Town to help locate a leak.

**Financial Report:** The financial report was reviewed.

**Town Administrator Report:** The Town Administrator's Report was reviewed. Budget was discussed, topics to focus on are: cleaning the playground equipment, replace the ground surface of the playground with mulch or rubber mulch; potholes on Hurtt Avenue; street and stop signs around Town; Robvanary Park Parking Lot. Hemstock asked if the council would be willing to provide a port-a-pot for the farmers market, a motion to provide the Farmers Market with a port-a-pot was made by Graybeal, a second was made by Manning; a vote of 5-0 was entered. Rice gave an update of Infinity Recycling.
