## TOWN OF MILLINGTON Resolution 2023-13 Amending the Town of Millington Chapter 2 – Ordinance Fines

WHEREAS, the Town Charter of the Town of Millington allows for the passing of all such ordinances not contrary to the Constitution and laws of the State of Maryland as it may deem necessary for the good government of the Town; for the protection and preservation of the Town's property, rights and privileges: for the preservation of peace and good order; for securing persons and property from violence, danger or destruction: and for the protection and promotion of the health, safety, comfort, convenience, welfare and happiness of the residents of the Town and visitors thereto and sojourners therein.

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 2 of the Code of the Town of Millington allows the Town to assess fines for Municipal Infractions;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved that certain sections of Chapter 2 regarding assessment of fines for Municipal Infractions have been amended;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this resolution and the attached revised Chapter 2 of the Town of Millington Code having been introduced on September 12, 2023 and a public hearing held on October 10, 2023, these revisions shall be effective immediately.
